

There are five levels in swimming. Here is a description of who may be interested.

The Level I Candidate:

Parents of new swimmers, students, local service club members, Master swimmers, any interested parties, and some of the swimmers themselves may become officials.

The Level II and III Candidate:

Those who are interested in moving up the ladder.

The Level IV (Senior) Candidate:

Level IV involves those officials who have worked actively at Level III for at least 1 year and have given every indication of continued participation. At this time, they may be interested in becoming involved with the local Swimming Officials Association.

The Level V (Master) Candidate:

Level IV officials, who have obtained considerable experience at all classes of meets including national caliber meets and have demonstrated a dedication to continuing active officiating, are eligible for elevation.
